



ASK Summer Enrichment COVID-19 Protocol

Population:

- Children must be at least one year off treatment. There is a limit of 15 children per week of Summer Enrichment.
- There will be at least four adult ASK staff members present.
- Staff and volunteers will be masked and vaccinated.

Prior to children's arrival:

- Per current CDC guidelines (<https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/community/disinfecting-building-facility.html>), ASK staff will disinfect hard surfaces in the offices each morning.
- Only essential personnel will be working on site during the week of camp.
- All parents/guardians will have read and signed the ASK COVID-19 Release (<https://forms.gle/kfYL5o1i3rgGuMed7>).
- Everyone will be required to wash or sanitize their hands upon arrival.
- Air purifiers will be placed throughout the program space and running continuously during the day to improve air circulation and quality.

Upon children's arrival:

- ASK staff will greet parent/guardian and child at the vehicle to ask about symptoms and exposure. ASK staff will take child's temperature with a forehead thermometer. Anyone with a temperature of 100° or higher will not be allowed to participate in Summer Enrichment that day and the next.
- Attendance will be kept every day for contact tracing.
- ASK staff will escort the child into the ASK program space.
- All children and staff will be required to wear a mask at all times while participating in programs; the only exception will be while eating (details below).

During the program day:

- As per the CDC guidelines (<https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/community/schools-childcare/operation-strategy.html>) and as long as area cases have a low positivity rate (<5%, <https://www.vdh.virginia.gov/coronavirus/health-professionals/virginia-long-term-care-task-force/covid-19-in-virginia-pcr-positivity-rates/>), children and adults will maintain at least 3' of physical distancing while participating in program activities.

- As per the CDC guidelines (<https://www.vdh.virginia.gov/coronavirus/summer-camp/>), children may share items (e.g. a ball) while playing. Children will wash or sanitize their hands before and after an activity.
- Parents/guardians will be strongly encouraged to send a clearly labeled water bottle for their child to use throughout the day to prevent an additional source of potential exposure.
- Snacks/Lunches:
 - We will eat inside and unmasked with 6' of physical distancing. Children will be assigned seats while eating in case we need to track potential exposure.
 - All food will be individually wrapped/boxed.

At the end of the day:

- Parents/guardians will text ASK staff to let them know they're there for pick-up. ASK staff will escort the child to their vehicle.
